## The Buzz about Bees

This is a **bee keeper**. The job of the bee keeper is to help the colony maintain a good population in order to pollinate and make honey for the bee keeper. Two out of every three bites of food you eat is pollinated by a honeybee. Bees can be protected from diseases, natural occurrences (weather) and pesticides by the bee keeper. Pollen is collected by the bee keeper to help people with allergies. Bees produce many byproducts used in our homes: beeswax for candles, honey, and royal jelly – which feeds the queen bee – but is also used in cosmetics and health food supplements.
